Help us achieve our vision with flexible funding!

As a non for profit paediatric teaching hospital, flexible funding is vital. It allows us to use funds where they are most needed, which enables us to save more lives.

Here are some examples of what your funding can do. Whatever your fundraising goal, Angkor Hospital for Children will help you set up your fundraising page and support you in reaching your target.

Stethoscopes

\$500 = 5 units

Our neonatal unit needs new stethoscopes, a vital piece of equipment used to check heart and lung sounds in patients across the hospital. For our neonates (newborns less than four weeks old) this is critical in ensuring they grow up healthy and strong.

Care for 6 HIV Patients

\$2,000 = care for 1 year

Our HIV/Homecare team work to ensure chronically ill children have access to life-saving medical and social care, helping them maintain independence and achieve the best possible quality of life. They care for over 530 children on anti-retroviral therapy.



Defibrillators

\$4,000 = 1 unit

Defibrillation is a treatment for life threatening cardiac irregularities that delivers a dose of electric current to the heart. We need 2 defibrillators for our emergency/intensive care units and for our Operating Theatre.

Children's Library

\$8,000 = cost of the entire project

To help de-stress our patients and make hospital visits a little more fun, we plan to build a children's library near our Outpatient Department. In our 2016 patient survey this was a recurring theme, especially for patients admitted for longer stays.

Sponsor a Resident Doctor

\$13,000 = sponsorship for 1 year

In 1979, after the Khmer Rouge were ousted, there remained only 39 doctors in Cambodia. AHC is regarded as one of the premier paediatric teaching sites of a limited number that provide practical training for medical students, residents and graduate doctors.

Run the Hospital

\$15,000 = 1 full day of operations

AHC employs approx. 70 doctors and over 200 nurses (and 250 support staff) who keep the hospital running at full capacity. Seeing between 400 - 600 patients each day in our Outpatient Department you could fund the entire operations for AHC for one whole day.



Curative Oncology Treatment

\$20,000 = care for 8 patients

AHC is the only facility in Cambodia that treats retinoblastoma, a rare form of eye cancer (almost exclusively affecting children) with chemotherapy and laser therapy. There is a 98% cure rate in the developed world but in Cambodia survival rates are low due to late diagnosis or lack of access to care.

Ventilators

\$35,000 = 1 unit

A ventilator is a life saving piece of equipment designed to provide breathing for a patient who is physically unable to breathe, or is breathing insufficiently. We need to replace up to 4 of these machines in our emergency/intensive care units to ensure these patients survive.
